

Eagle Lake Kitchen Assistant

The most common phrase we hear from people who work at Eagle Lake on our summer staff is **“It was the best summer of my life, and it was the hardest summer of my life.”** The job of the kitchen assistant at Eagle Lake Camps is to provide Christ-centered direction and support in preparing meals for up to 350 people each day, to uphold camp policies, and to love His kids. All of our summer staff are expected to live out the following Biblical principles in excellence:

- Have a consistent walk with the Lord to model and pass on to campers and other staff
- Possess a practical, working knowledge of the Bible and be ready to “give an answer” (1 Peter 3:15)
- Self-motivation to serve faithfully, excellently, and whole-heartedly in your role
- In interactions with Crew campers working under you to seek opportunities to minister to and encourage them in their “Luke 2:52 growth”
- Uphold and support camp policies and leadership, offering constructive feedback when necessary
- Adhere to Eagle Lake Camps’ relational covenant:
 - Believe the best in each other
 - Stand shoulder to shoulder with one another
 - Talk to and not about one another

Kitchen Assistant Job Description:

As the kitchen assistant, you will have a unique opportunity to serve campers and staff by providing meals each day. The kitchen assistant works under our Food Service Director to plan and prepare 3 meals a day for up to 350 people, and assists in ordering and inventory of food items. The kitchen assistant directs Crew counselors and campers in the actual preparation of the food.

Responsibilities and Expectations for Kitchen Assistant:

- Serve in the kitchen at our overnight property, directing Crew counselors and campers in meal prep
- Assist Food Service Director in meal plan and prep and food order and inventory

- Be on time to all meetings, meals, and scheduled rotations, being flexible to any last minute changes assigned by leadership staff
- Prepare throughout the week and come ready for in-depth discussion in staff Bible study
- Support counselors and leadership as needed
- **Commit to Eagle Lake's Core Beliefs**

We commit to the following support and compensation:

- Housing and food during the duration of employment
 - Salary of \$100/week
 - 24 hours off/week
 - Approachable leadership who are always available for conversation to encourage, challenge, or discuss any camp issues
