The most common phrase we hear from people who work at Eagle Lake on our summer staff is "It was the best summer of my life, and it was the hardest summer of my life." The job of the photographer at Eagle Lake Camps is to provide Christ-centered service and support by capturing all of the moments that make a camper's week special. All of our summer staff are expected to live out the following Biblical principles in excellence:

- Have a consistent walk with the Lord to model and pass on to campers and other staff
- Possess a practical, working knowledge of the Bible and be ready to "give an answer" (1 Peter 3:15)
- Self-motivation to serve faithfully, excellently, and whole-heartedly in your role
- In interactions with campers, seek opportunities to minister to and encourage them in their "Luke 2:52 growth"
- Uphold and support camp policies and leadership, offering constructive feedback when necessary
- Adhere to Eagle Lake Camps' relational covenant:
 - Believe the best in each other
 - o Stand shoulder to shoulder with one another
 - Talk to and not about one another

Photographer Job Description:

As a photographer, you will serve with our media team at our overnight property. The photographer captures all the moments that makes a camper's week exceptional, and then edits the photos, uploads these to Smugmug (an online photo sharing website) several times a week for parents to view, and creates a photo album. The photographer is provided with the necessary equipment and software, although you may use your personal equipment and software if you prefer.

Responsibilities and Expectations for Photographer:

- Work on media team with competency and excellency
- Capture week's important moments, edit them, upload them to Smugmug several times a week, and create a slideshow to show at the end of the week

- Be on time to all meetings, meals, and scheduled rotations, being flexible to any last minute changes assigned by leadership staff
- Prepare throughout the week and come ready for in-depth discussion in staff Bible study
- Support counselors and leadership as needed
- Commit to Eagle Lake's Core Beliefs

We commit to the following support and compensation:

- Housing and food during the duration of employment
- Salary of \$100/week
- 24 hours off/week
- Approachable leadership who are always available for conversation to encourage, challenge, or discuss any camp issues
